

How to Become a CRS Member

To become a CRS member, you must:

- reside in Arizona
 - be a legal U.S. citizen
 - be under the age of 21 years
 - have a qualifying, medically eligible condition (see [Covered and Excluded Conditions](#))

Although membership is not driven by income, you will be asked to submit financial information to determine your potential out-of-pocket costs for the program benefits. Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) members are automatically financially eligible.

What to bring with you for the financial interview:

- Health Insurance Card
- Guardianship Papers
- Proof of Residency
- Social Security Number
- Proof of Child's Age (i.e. birth certificate)
- Earnings, Self-employment
- Unearned Income and Child Support
- Child Care (bills and paid receipts)
- Medical Expenses (Paid and Unpaid)
- Identification for Parent or Legal Guardian (driver's license, state ID card, etc)

Who can submit an application to CRS on behalf of a child?:

- Anyone- Pediatrician, Nurse, Social Worker, Parent/ Guardian, School Nurse, etc.
